Please consider joining our Charlesmont Library Community. This year, we are encouraging you to apply for a Charlesmont Library Card. This card will enable you to borrow books from our school library. You can browse the shelves and check out books during the morning from 8:40 until 9:05 each day, except on Book Fair Days or when schools are closed for students.

There are many advantages for you to borrow books from our school library. One of the most important reasons is so you and your child can spend more time reading books you both enjoy, together at home. Many times, students wish to borrow more books than permitted and if there is a strong interest in a subject, you can now borrow books for them, as well. Younger students often request to borrow books they are not able to read, since the reading level is too high for them, but you may check out these books on your own card and read it with them. Your book selections also help to give the children a more varied reading experience.

Our library contains many topics which may interest you as well. Our collection is outstanding and you will find books in all areas of interest for yourself, as well as for your children. The books in our collection support our school curriculum in all subject areas and also contain topics of high interest, as well.

Please join us in the pleasure and learning found in books and fill out the attached application form. Return the form to Ms. Muskauski with your child and it will be sent to the Baltimore County Public Schools Library Office for processing. This usually takes a few days. After that time, you may borrow the books of your choice. When you are ready to return the books, you may either send them to the library in the morning with your child or return yourself to borrow more.
